**Note 1:** Luther College Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Student Definition = Number of full-time degree seeking students+[(total credit hours of full-time non-degree seeking students+total credit hours of part-time degree seeking students+total credit hours of part-time non-degree seeking students)/12]. **Note 2:** Number of international students is defined as the number of Luther students coded as non-resident aliens in the administrative database at fall enrollment census. As defined by the U.S. Department of Education, a non-resident alien is a person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who is in this country on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely. **Note 3:** In accordance with IPEDS reporting requirements, First-Year Cohort includes all first time, full-time, first year degree seeking students. Students who meet this requirement, regardless of the number of advanced standing credits they bring with them to Luther, are included in the FY Cohort.
