**ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM OF THE COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION BOARD**

Luther College participates in the Advanced Placement Program of the College Entrance Examination Board. Through enrollment in special courses in a participating high school, a qualified high school senior may take achievement examinations in one or more academic subjects at the college level. Scores of 4 or 5 are accepted for credit. Four semester hours of credit are awarded for each exam. Listed below are the AP exam titles and the Luther course equivalencies normally issued. Also listed is an indication of how each course would typically be used toward the general or major requirements. The course equivalencies and how the courses apply toward the general or major requirements are subject to change.
