# The 2023-24 Luther College Co-Curricular Activities Fee

## The Co-curricular Activities Fee (CAF) allows you to:

- Attend events on campus presented by Student Activities Council (SAC) and Performing Arts Committee (PAC) free of charge or at a significantly reduced rate.
- Support activities on campus. The CAF supplies funds for the diverse events, activities and performing artists who come to our campus.
- Bring art to campus. Luther's art galleries, supported in part by CAF funds, exhibit a wide range of visual artists from the Luther community, and the world beyond.
- Fund student organizations which in turn support your interests! The CAF provides substantial funding to student organizations, distributed by Student Senate. This makes it possible for organizations to present events such as the International Students and Allies Association's amazing annual fashion show, Intersectional Feminist "Monologues," and the BSU talent show.

#### **About Student Activities Council**

**SAC** brings nationally known recording artists to Luther, including Lizzo, T-Pain, Quinn XCII, Macklemore & Ryan Lewis, X Ambassadors, Ben Rector, Pentatonix, Nick Jonas, Jason Derulo, FUN, Panic! at the Disco, and Judah and the Lion.

SAC sponsors other **entertainment** like ComedySportz, Magician Peter Boie, National Poetry Slam champion Neil Hilborn, Escape Rooms, newly released films, Trivia Nights, Family Weekend Soda Shoppe, Open Mic Night, Promo Night, Jazz Night, and Homecoming Parade.

SAC sponsors **service projects** such as the Lutheran World Relief blanket project, Christmas Cheer, and letter writing to veterans.

SAC **co-sponsors activities** with Counseling, Wellness, College Ministries, the Center for Intercultural Engagement and Student Success (CIES) and student organizations such as the Ballroom Swing Dance, the Luther Baseball Team, Latines Unides, and more, all made possible with CAF funds.

#### **About Performing Arts Committee**

PAC brings world-class performing artists to Luther through the Center Stage Series. The Center Stage Series often includes programming connected to Paideia and other departments, who encourage students to attend. Rosanne Cash, Rhythmic Circus, Philip Glass, Vanguard Jazz, The Blind Boys of Alabama, The Ukulele Orchestra of Great Britain, Ladysmith Black Mambazo, and Cantus have all recently performed at Luther. The artists brought by PAC usually offer master classes, pop-up concerts, and outreach activities while in residence. (The 2023-24 Center Stage Series will be announced this spring at tickets.luther.edu.)

The 2023-24 CAF will be \$270 for full-time students. A one semester CAF (\$135) is only for those participating in student teaching, internships, or study away. See deadlines below.
