# Luther College Health Services now the Luther Clinic

Beginning this fall, Winneshiek Medical Center will assume full responsibility for the health care services available to students on campus. The new model of care expands health care services for students and allows both organizations to focus on their areas of specialization: WMC in providing quality health care; Luther College in providing an exceptional education.

## **Mental Health Services**

As parents and family of college students, you likely know that <u>students today</u> have higher rates of depression, anxiety and other mental health disorders.

Mental Health services are provided through Luther College Counseling Service (LCCS) for students in a variety of formats. On campus support can be accessed via the <u>LCCS</u> <u>website</u>.

An extension of LCCS is now being offered to all Luther students, regardless of location. This service is called <u>My Student Support Program (My SSP</u>). My SSP connects students with free, confidential mental health and wellbeing support conveniently available 24/7 via the My SSP app, telephone and web.

## **Financial Reminders**

We would like to start off with a thank you for your patience as the college transitioned to a new phone system at the end of July. As our call volume continues to increase with the start of the academic year, please know that you can also email Financial Aid at

<u>finaid@luther.edu</u> or Student Accounts at <u>studentaccounts@luther.edu</u> with your questions if you are unable to connect with us via phone.

- Staff from the Financial Aid and Student Account offices will be available 10 a.m.–3 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 27, on the main floor of the Dahl Centennial Union to assist with documents and answer any questions.
- If your student is planning to work during the first semester, they must complete Federal and State W-4 Forms and the Federal I9 Form prior to beginning employment. The I9 must be completed in person and requires original documents proving identity and citizenship status. Please refer to the I9 for a list of acceptable documents.
- Checks for outside scholarships need to be brought to the Financial Aid Office so that they can be credited to the student's account.
- Students can grant proxy access to their NorseHub accounts so that parents or guardians can view financial aid offers, statement of account balances, and academic information electronically. Due to privacy rights, the college cannot share a student's information without their consent and the student can select the information that they want to share.
- If the Financial Aid Office is missing documents needed to complete a student's financial aid file, the student will receive an email approximately every two weeks asking them to review their missing documents on NorseHub and complete them.
- Students are paid bi-weekly for any on-campus employment earnings. The first payroll will be Sep. 28 for hours earned through Sept. 16, 2022.
- **Revised financial aid offers are no longer being mailed** to incoming students. Students are notified of revisions via an email message directing them to view the revised aid offer on NorseHub.
- Tuition payments were due in full Aug. 10 or monthly payments can be scheduled. Monthly late fees of \$100 will be assessed on overdue balances above \$1,000. Contact Student Accounts at 563-387-1015 or email at studentaccounts@luther.edu for questions.
