✓ An **itinerant student** is defined as a Luther College student who intends to participate in an off-campus academic program under the auspices of an accredited college or university, or institute, other than Luther College. Such programs might include a study abroad program affiliated with (but not administered by) Luther College or a course of study at another American university used to enhance the major program at Luther.

✓ Other programs have been approved for **off-campus residency**, including cooperative programs in medical technology, cyto-technology, physical therapy, medicine, dentistry, engineering. These programs are listed in the "liberal arts and careers" section of the Luther College Catalog.

The following guidelines apply to a student with itinerant/off-campus residence status:

- The application for itinerant/off-campus residence status must be completed and on file in the Registrar's Office.
- Itinerant/off-campus residence status maintains your enrollment as a full-time student at Luther College.
- Your statement of account will show a "tuition itinerant fee" of \$470 during the term that you are participating in this program. If you change programs during the year, your account will reflect an additional itinerant fee for that additional term.
- You are not considered withdrawn or on academic leave from Luther. (Application for readmission to Luther is not required.)
- Luther College agrees to accept the credits earned in this program (as transfer credits) provided the courses are previously approved and the grades earned are C- or above. Courses should be approved on the standard "Course Approval Form" available in the Registrar's Office, or in an equivalent manner.
- If you are receiving any need-based financial assistance through Luther, a "Consortium/Contractual Agreement" form must be completed and returned to the Luther Financial Aid Office for submission to your program. Application for financial assistance toward the cost of the program must be made with the home institution (Luther College).
- You are responsible for requesting a final official academic transcript from the host institution, which is to be sent directly to Luther College when the program is completed. The transcript will become a part of your permanent record at Luther.
