Musical Needs

- Festival music - *Music is emailed to teachers. Teachers must print out for students.*
- Lesson music if applicable
- A pencil and folder for music
- Your instrument (excludes many percussion instruments)
- A stand
- Any necessary instrument “repair” items: ex. Valve oil

Overnight, Housing Needs

- Sleeping Bag - *many students, if not all, will be sleeping on the floor*
- Pillow
- Towels
- Toiletries

Medical Needs

- If you have any allergies, please be sure to bring your EpiPen and have it on your person
- If you have asthma, please be sure to bring your inhaler
- If you have any prescription medications, do not forget to bring these with you

Clothing Needs

- Concert attire:
 - Option A: All black
 - Option B: White top and black bottoms with black, closed toe shoes for all students.
 - Long ties are encouraged for those who choose to wear them.
- Warm, winter clothing – coats, hats, gloves, and scarves for the long walks across our cold and windy campus in the beginning of February!

Food Needs

- Bring a water bottle and carry it with you.
- Discuss with your director about what the plans are for eating on-campus or off-campus.
- On campus options include the Cafeteria, Marty’s Grill, and Oneota Market. Cafeteria tickets are available for purchase online or at the time of registration. Dorian Cafeteria Prices: Breakfast: \$8, Lunch: \$10, Dinner: \$10. If you wait to buy tickets at the cafeteria door, you will not get the discounted Dorian price.
- Off campus options include Subway, Culvers, McDonalds, Pizza Hut, Pizza Ranch, Old Armory BBQ, Mabe’s Pizza, Family Table Restaurant, T-Bocks, Koreana, The Landing Market
- REMINDER: No food or drink in the CFL Main Hall - only water!

Cash

- We will have Dorian merchandise for sale (cash/check only), and the Luther College Bookstore will be open on Monday for participants if they would like to shop around (cash/check/card).

What NOT to bring
