

2024-25 Luther College Cost Estimate Worksheet

How much should I expect to pay directly to Luther? This is one of the most frequently asked questions by students and families in planning for college. This worksheet should better assist you in understanding your total charges and the portion that will be covered by the financial aid offered to you. The remaining amount is your family's cost for the year. Review the information on the financial aid website, finaid.luther.edu, to fully understand what you have been offered and to explore other financing options that may be available to you and your family.

Part Three: Estimate What You Will Pay

Subtract the total estimated credits from the total estimated charges to determine the approximate	
amount you will owe Luther College for the full academic year:	\$
Work-Study: Earnings are normally used to cover personal expenses during the school year. However, by	
participating in the Work Study Payment Agreement, you may to apply up to 90% of your earrings to your	
bill by completing a Work Study Payment Agreement Application. (example: \$2,500 x 0.90 = \$2,250)	\$

Other Expenses to Consider: It is a good idea to work out your own personal budget each year so you'll know ahead of time what your total out-of-pocket expenses will be. For the academic year, we estimate the cost of books and supplies at \$1,040, transportation at \$1,290, and personal expenses at \$1656. These expenses will vary according to individual needs. <u>You should plan</u> to bring funds with you to cover your fall books and initial personal expenses.
