Your 2024–2025 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. To verify that you provided correct information, the Financial Aid Office at Luther College will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documents. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and spouse (if applicable) must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Luther College Financial Aid Office.

The provided criteria for “dependent children” or “other persons” align with the requirement that family size align with whom the student could claim as a dependent on a U.S. tax return if the student were to file a U.S tax return at the time of completing the 2024-2025 FAFSA. As a result, the student should not include any unborn children in the family size
