Tentative social work courses by semester

A few notes about planning your courses:

- 1) It is ideal to take SW 102 no later than January of sophomore year; must be completed before start of junior year.
- 2) Admission to the major typically occurs in the spring of sophomore year once you have completed SW 101 and SW 102; admission to the major is required before enrolling in SW 301.
- 3) SW 201 must come before SW 301; SW 301 and SW 401 can be taken concurrently if necessary
- 4) Students also need to complete POLS 247 (I, H) **and** BIO 115 (NWL) **or** BIO 113(NWNL)
