LUTHER COLLEGE POLICY ADVANCED PLACEMENT PROGRAM OF THE COLLEGE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION BOARD

Luther College participates in the Advanced Placement Program of the College Entrance Examination Board. Through enrollment in special courses in a participating high school, a qualified high school senior may take achievement examinations in one or more academic subjects at the college level. Scores of 4 or 5 are accepted for credit. With the exception of the Calculus BC exam (which will earn 8 total credits), four semester hours of credit are awarded for each AP exam. Listed below are the exam titles and the Luther course equivalency issued. Also listed is an indication of how each course would typically be used toward the general or major requirements. The course equivalencies and how the courses apply toward the general or major requirements are subject to change, and an official evaluation will be completed by the Registrar's Office.
