IMPORTANT NOTES:

- Courses that fulfill Luther College general education requirements must carry 3 or more credits and a grade of C- or higher.
- No more than one literacy, Global Engagement (GE), or Paideia requirement may be fulfilled by taking a single course; but a course that fulfills a literacy or GE can also be used to satisfy the Social & Environmental Justice requirement.
- With consideration to possible changes in the NIACC or Luther catalogs, this resource doesn't serve as official evaluation. Transfer coursework will be officially evaluated by the Luther Registrar's Office upon application/enrollment.
- This resource is compiled from NIACC courses that meet the NIACC gen-eds. It's possible that courses not assigned to an NIACC gen-ed could fulfill a Luther gen-ed. Such decisions would be made by the Luther Registrar's Office.

PAID 111D/112D, FIRST YEAR REQUIREMENT Some transfer students **may** be eligible to use one or two composition courses (taken post high school) for the fulfillment of one or both Paideia courses. Eligibility for this will be determined by admit status (number of post-HS college credits transferred to Luther).
