An independent project is any project originated by the student (as opposed to faculty, staff, or an organization). Examples may include (but are not limited to) original research or field work projects, original creative projects (design, marketing, art, etc.), or technology projects like creating an app or a computer program. All independent projects must conclude with a tangible, original, or innovative output.

The faculty member approving this proposal should be someone familiar with your knowledge/ability level as well as the subject matter. It does not have to be your academic advisor.
