
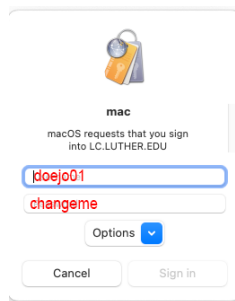


macOS Quick Start Guide

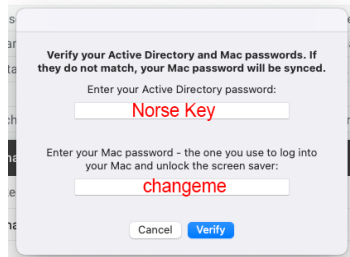
Your workstation password is now: **changeme**

Please log onto your workstation before leaving campus.

1. Log in with the password provided above and connect to a wireless network (see below).
2. A box will appear asking for your username and password. (If this box does not appear, click on the Key icon  in the menu bar & select Sign In.)



3. In Username, enter your Username (i.e. doejo01). In Password, enter your Norse Key (i.e. what you use for your email, etc) and click Sign In.

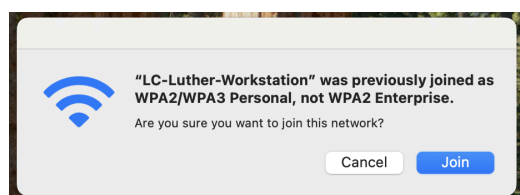


4. Another box will appear. In the top box: Enter your Norse Key. In the bottom box, enter the password used for your computer (i.e. changeme).
5. Your password is now synced and you will now log onto your workstation using your Norse Key.

Note - This will only work while on the Luther network (i.e. on campus or using a VPN).

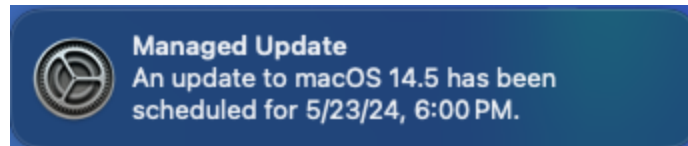
Wireless Network

When you first sign in, you will need to connect to the LC-Luther-Workstation wireless network. If you see the message below, click Join and then enter your Username and Password. You should only have to do this once.



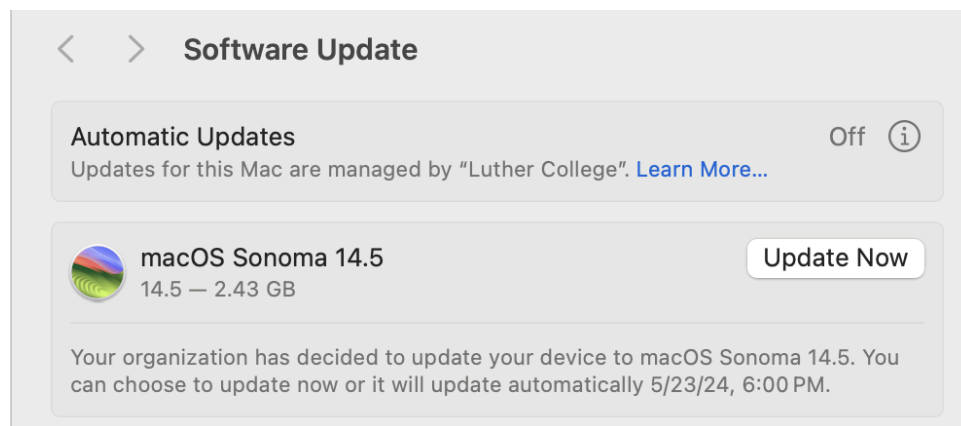
macOS Updates

With macOS Sonoma, macOS updates are easier than ever before. When a macOS update is available, a notification similar to the one below will appear in the upper right corner:



If nothing is done, the macOS Update will install on the date and time indicated. If the computer is off during this time, the update will install within 60 minutes of being powered on.

You can choose to update now by clicking on the notification. Once the update has been downloaded, click **Update Now** and enter your password when prompted (you do not have to be an administrator).



Updates take between 15 - 45 minutes to complete. During this time you will not be able to use your computer.
